It is Anixter's intention to have this policy in place as soon as practicable.

C. Do you require your direct suppliers to be DRC conflict-free? (*)	No	As with most companies similar to Anixter, Anixter is still in the process of determining the DRC conflict-free status of its suppliers. Once our policy is in place, we will request all our suppliers to be DRC conflict-free.
